

Australian Billiards & Snooker Council National Selection Criteria - Masters

Selection for players to represent Australia will be as per the International Representation Criteria in addition to the selection process below:

- Winner of the Australian Masters Championship.
- Highest Ranked eligible player on the National Ranking List after the Australian National Men's Snooker Championship. Players must have competed in the Australian Masters Championship to be eligible for selection.
- If these players are the same then the next Ranked player will be offered the position.
- If either of these players are unavailable, and for remaining selections, the Seeding and Selection Committee will reserve the right to select a player, using the National Ranking List.

Note:

- All these selections are subject to the confirmation of the Seeding and Selection committee of the ABSC, in particular with reference to players being of a suitable standard and character to represent Australia.
- Consideration could be given to players unable to contest the Masters Championship if written
 evidence is provided explaining the circumstances that prevented the player from contesting
 the Championship.
- Players must meet age requirements for the event i.e. must be at least 40 years of age prior to 1 January in the year of competition.
