

Tournament Conditions and Information 2024 Dr Clem Jones AO QLD Open Snooker Championship

Conditions of Entry

- 1. The Tournament will be conducted under the Australian Billiards and Snooker Council Championship Playing Conditions, and all matters pertaining to Players' Code of Conduct will be adhered to.
- 2. Nominations are accepted from Countries from Asia and the Oceania/Pacific region.
- 3. Players may be subjected to Drug testing in accordance with the ABSC Drugs in Sport Policy.
- 4. All Australian players are required to complete the Sport Integrity Australia Anti-Doping Fundamentals online course which is available on the Sports Integrity Australia website https://elearning.sportintegrity.gov.au. You will need to create an account to access the course, and once completed you will be sent an electronic certificate of attainment that you may be required to produce as a condition of entry.
- 5. INDEMNITY: All participants enter at their own risk. Neither the Club, nor sponsors, nor organisers shall be liable for any loss, injury or misadventure however arising.

Conditions of Play

- 1. The format of the Championships will be a straight knockout draw.
- 2. All matches will be best of 5 up until the Quarter and Semi Finals which will be best of 7 and the Final best of 9.
- 3. The "Mercy Rule" (3 snookers + 1 point) will be in effect up until the round of last 16 and it will not be applied to any deciding frames.
- 4. Tournament standard dress is required: Predominately plain coloured polo shirt or long sleeve dress shirt buttoned at the wrist, dress pants and dark colour dress shoes. Polo shirts must have a collar and be predominately plain or snooker related. Work and pool related polos will not be accepted. Jeans or casual pants will not be accepted. Joggers and other non-dress shoes will not be accepted unless a medical certificate is provided to the tournament director before your match. Waistcoat and bow tie will be required from the quarter finals onwards. Failure to comply with these conditions will result in a forfeiture of the match.
- 5. All players are to report to the Tournament Director at least 15 minutes before their scheduled starting time and are to be ready to play at this time. Once a match has been called, players will have 5 minutes to make their way to the table and be ready to play. Failure to comply will result in a forfeiture of 1 frame. A further frame will be forfeited for each 15 minutes late to the table.
- 6. Slow play will not be tolerated. If the Referee deems that play is slower than necessary, a warning may be given. Any further slow play will result in loss of the match.
- 7. Mobile phones must not be used and are to be either switched off or placed on silent for the duration of the match. Failure to comply will result in a loss of frame for the first infringement and loss of match for any further infringement.
- 8. Smoking, Vaping, the use of E-cigarettes or the consumption of alcohol during matches (including between frames) is not allowed. Any infringements will result in the loss of the match.

Prize Money

1. The tournament guarantees a minimum of \$10,000 in total prize money. This amount may increase depending on the number of entries received.





Accommodation and Airport Transfers

Free transfers between the airport and the venue will be available for interstate players. Please let the tournament director know if you require this service.
