

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

DRESS CODE

Championship Dress Code is required: Predominantly plain coloured shirts with sleeves below the elbow, dark trousers, or dark skirts, no shorter than kneecap must be worn for all matches, waistcoats to be worn for Knock-Out stages onwards. Dark coloured ladies' dress shoes shall be worn at all sessions and may be open or closed toe. No sports style shoes, sandals, or boots will be allowed. Failure to comply with these conditions will result in forfeiture of the game. The Tournament Director may vary this dress code in extreme circumstances.

VENUES

Participants will have the pleasure of competing in the round robin matches at both the Cheltenham Club and Hampton RSL, renowned for their welcoming atmosphere and excellent facilities.

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1. The Championship will be conducted under <u>Australian Billiards and Snooker Council Championship Playing Conditions</u>, and all matters pertaining to the Members' Protection Policy and the Players' Code of Conduct must be adhered to.
- 2. Entrants must be a financial member of an affiliated State/Territory Association of the Australian Billiards and Snooker Council and must be an Australian Citizen.
- 3. Format of the tournament is a ROUND ROBIN draw, the top 2 players from each group (at a minimum) will qualify for the knockout stage. The draw will be at the discretion of the organizing committee and no debate will be entered. The frames played per round-robin match will depend on entry numbers and available tables.
- 4. Championship Dress Code is required: Predominantly plain coloured shirts with sleeves below the elbow, dark trousers, or dark skirts, no shorter than kneecap must be worn for all matches, waistcoats to be worn for Knock-Out stages onwards. Dark coloured ladies' dress shoes shall be worn at all sessions and may be open or closed toe. No sports style shoes, sandals, or boots will be allowed. Failure to comply with these conditions will result in forfeiture of the game. The Tournament Director may vary this dress code in extreme circumstances.
- 5. NOTE: Players may be required to referee their own Round Robin games, with roving referees on-hand to assist. Referees will be provided for knockout games.
- 6. All players are to be ready to play at least 15 minutes before the scheduled start of their match. Refer to the Australian Championship Playing Conditions Point 6 applies to a player or players not ready to commence their match on time.
- 7. Seeding into the knock-out stage from the round robin will be calculated in accordance with Condition 9 of the Australian Championship Playing Conditions.
- 8. Changes may be made at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
- 9. Players may be subjected to drug testing in accordance with the ABSC Drugs in Sport Policy.
- 10. Indemnity & Acknowledgement: All participants enter at their own risk. None of the ABSC, the VBSA, the venue, the sponsors nor the organisers shall be responsible for any loss, injury or misadventure arising.
- 11. A player who gives a walkover in a knock-out match, without prior approval of exceptional circumstances by the Tournament Director, will forfeit their right to any prize monies.
