- The event is open to players from all countries.
- SBNSW welcomes players and officials of all genders.
- Players must be financial members of their Affiliate State or National Federation and in good standing.

Tournament Terms & Conditions

- The Tournament will be played subject to the Rules of Snooker as prescribed by the WPBSA.
- ABSC Playing Conditions and all matters pertaining to Player's Code of Conduct and Ethics will also be adhered to. Any breach of such rules or non-adherence to standard etiquette may result in disciplinary action being taken against the offenders.
- No players or referees are permitted to smoke/ vape or consume alcohol whilst involved in playing or refereeing a game unless during an official session break.
- Players must be financial members of their Affiliate State or National Federation and in good standing.
- Players may be subjected to Drug testing in accordance with the ABSC Drugs in Sport Policy
- A prize pool of \$12,000* will be payable due to National Ranking status. *Subject to entries
- Seedings will apply based on the National Snooker Rankings as per the ABSC website.
- Format: straight knock-out over best of five (5) frames; Final best of seven (7) frames.
- Play starts on Friday 9.30am for NSW players Friday 2pm for NSW country and interstate if required.
- In the absence of official referees, players will be required to referee their games in the early rounds. Official referees will be made available from Last 16 onwards.
- Players are asked to please brush and pad the table on completion of their games.
- Dress Code: Tailored trousers, SBNSW or Official State Polo shirt or a plain Black or White polo, or long sleeve predominately plain coloured shirt, dark colour dress shoes for Friday & Saturday.
- Full Dress required on Sunday. Failure to comply with these conditions will result in forfeiture of the game.
- Completed online entry form and entry fee (www.snookernsw.com/store) will be required before any player is permitted to compete.
- Players will receive an email within 7 days of the tournament with the draw and important information.
- Tournament Director may vary T&Cs if needed.
- This entry form constitutes part of the conditions of entry.
- Indemnity & Acknowledgement: All participants enter at their own risk. None of the ABSC, the SBNSW, the venue, the sponsors nor the organisers shall be responsible for any loss, injury or misadventure arising.

Transport

No airport transport is provided for this event, however, public transport is available from Sydney Airport. The venue is around 10-12 minutes drive from the close hotels. Taxi/Uber fares are around \$15-\$25.

VENUE TRANSPORT

SHUTTLE	Limtied transport from Mercure to Venue can be arranged - with prior notice only. The venue also operates a regular shuttle within a 5km radius of the club, with drop-offs starting from 5.00pm	
TRAIN	Blacktown Workers Club is located just a short 5-10 min walk from Blacktown Train Station.	
AIPORT TRANSPORT		
TRAIN	Trains to Blacktown Station leave regularly from the Sydney Domestic terminals. The journey takes around 50 minutes and costs approx \$20-\$30. Train travel requires an Opal Card, which can be purchased at the Airport stations.	
TAXI & UBER	Taxi fares from the airport to the hotel precinct and Blacktown Workers will take 45-60 minutes, depending on traffic, and will be fairly costly. Uber and other services are readily available.	
PRIVATE SHUTTLE	Private shuttles from the airport to the venue/ hotel may be an economical option for multiple players sharing costs. Book online in advance. Examples: airportstaxitransfers.com; www.jayride.com
