### 2022 BOB HAWKE AC AUSTRALIAN OPEN SNOOKER CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. The Championships will be conducted under the Australian Billiards and Snooker Council Championship Playing Conditions, and all matters pertaining to Players' Code of Conduct will be adhered to.
- 2. Nominees must be a financial member of an affiliate of the Australian Billiards and Snooker Council or the International Billiards & Snooker Federation.
- 3. A completed Entry form and entry fee will be required before any player is permitted to compete.
- 4. The format of the Championships will be a seeded knockout draw.
- 5. Tournament standard dress is required: Long sleeve predominately plain coloured shirts buttoned at the wrist, bow ties and dark colour dress shoes must be worn for all matches. Waistcoat is required from the quarter finals onwards. Failure to comply with these conditions will result in forfeiture of the match.
- 6. All players are to report to the Tournament Director 15 minutes before their scheduled starting time, and are to be ready to play at this time. Some first round matches between local players will be required to play on Thursday evening, no earlier than 4pm. Interstate players ranked in the Top 16 will not be introduced into the Tournament until Friday evening. Other Interstate players may be required earlier on Friday.
- 7. A Consolation Plate event will be held on the Sunday for all first round losers. Prize money will be subject to entries received.
- 8. This entry form constitutes part of the conditions of entry. Changes may be made at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
- 9. Players may be subjected to Drug testing in accordance with the ABSC Drugs in Sport Policy.
- 10. All Australian players are required to complete the Sport Integrity Australia Anti-doping Fundamentals on-line course which is available on the Sports Integrity Australia website <a href="https://elearning.sportintegrity.gov.au">https://elearning.sportintegrity.gov.au</a>. You will need to create an account to access the course, and once completed you will be sent an electronic certificate of attainment that you may be required to produce as a condition of entry.
- 11. INDEMNITY: All participants enter at their own risk. Neither the Club, nor sponsors, nor organisers shall be liable for any loss, injury or misadventure however arising.
