- 1. The Championships will be conducted under Australian Billiards and Snooker Council Playing Conditions, and all matters pertaining to Players' Code of Conduct will be adhered to.
- 2. Nominees must be a financial member of an affiliate of the Australian Billiards and Snooker Council and aged under the age of the relevant Championship as at 1/1/2023 Entries will only be received on the official entry form.
- 3. The format of the Challenge will be round robin with teams progressing to a semifinal draw. (Subject to entries)
- 4. Tournament standard dress is required (long sleeved collared shirt, bowtie, dress pants in a solid dark colour, dress shoes and socks).
- Vest is required. Failure to comply with this condition will result in forfeiture of the match.
- 5. All Teams are to report to the Tournament Director 15 minutes before their scheduled starting time and are to be ready to play at this time.
- 6. This entry form constitutes part of the conditions of entry. Changes may be made at the discretion of the Tournament Director.
- 7. Players may be subjected to Drug testing in accordance with the ABSC Drugs in Sport Policy.
- 8. Players must have participated in their Individual State Junior Championship to be eligible to be part of their State Team, unless otherwise approved by the ABSC.
