2024 APSBF OPEN REGIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- 1. The Championships will be conducted under the Australian Billiards and Snooker Council Championship Playing Conditions, and all matters pertaining to Players' Code of Conduct will be adhered to.
- 2. Nominations are accepted from Countries from the Oceania/Pacific region and Asian countries bordering on the Pacific. Member Countries are Australia, New Zealand, Papua New Guinea, Fiji.
- 3. The format of the Championships will be a round robin stage with qualifiers progressing to the knockout draw.
- 4. Tournament standard dress is required: Long sleeve predominately plain coloured shirts buttoned at the wrist, bow ties and dark colour dress shoes must be worn for all matches. Waistcoat is required from the quarter finals onwards. Failure to comply with these conditions will result in forfeiture of the match.
- 5. All players are to report to the Tournament Director 15 minutes before their scheduled starting time, and are to be ready to play at this time,
- 6. Players may be subjected to Drug testing in accordance with the ABSC Drugs in Sport Policy.
- 7. All Australian players are required to complete the Sport Integrity Australia Anti-Doping Fundamentals on-line course which is available on the Sports Integrity Australia website https://elearning.sportintegrity.gov.au. You will need to create an account to access the course, and once completed you will be sent an electronic certificate of attainment that you may be required to produce as a condition of entry.
- INDEMNITY: All participants enter at their own risk. Neither the Club, nor sponsors, nor organisers shall be liable for any loss, injury or misadventure however arising.
