Appointed Executive Member – Players' Advocate Role & Responsibilities 30 August 2018

The Women's Advocate play an important role in the development and success of snooker & billiards (**the Sport**) for women in Australia. Set out below is an overview of the position.

As an elected member of the Executive, the Appointed Executive Member will be actively involved in the administration of the Sport. This will include:-

1. Attending the AGM and Executive Meetings and being part of the decision-making processes (both formal and electronic) throughout the year.
2. Contributing to sub-committees as needs be.
3. Providing ongoing feedback about all aspects of the Sport from the female players' points of view on the basis that they represent players at all levels of ability in the Sport.
4. Fostering the Sport and providing an avenue for the women in the playing community to bring forward issues and suggestions to the Executive Committee.

The general responsibilities include:-

- A. liaising with female players at all levels of the Sport and representing their interests in the Executive Committee;
- B. contributing positively on social media and acting as a strong advocate and ambassador for the Sport as a whole whilst re-inforcing the ABSC's core values of integrity, communication, trust and accountability;
- C. identifying potential sponsor opportunities;
- D. assisting in female player grant submissions and funding opportunities;
- E. identifying opportunities for revenue raising for funds to enhance to female player representation overseas;
- F. working collaboratively in different facets of the administration of the Sport including media, referees, coaching, women and junior development; and
- G. liaising with the other Appointed Executive Members to coordinate player meetings where appropriate including at all major national events.
